### STUDENT CHAPTER SUPPORT ACTIVITIES

TEAM is affiliated with two ITE student chapters: Washington University and Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville. TEAM offers free registration to all students at their monthly meetings and annual Transportation Fair.

Established in 1974, the Washington University Student Chapter has a long history supporting ITE activities. The student chapter traditionally holds their monthly meetings in conjunction with the monthly TEAM meetings.

Although Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville's student chapter is relatively young it is very active. In 2010, the SIUE Student Chapter enjoyed its third full calendar year as a part of ITE since reactivation in September 2007. The Chapter

maintained official recognition from the University as a registered student organization. In addition, new members were recruited, making it one of the largest Civil Engineering clubs on campus by enrollment. Officials from the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), Missouri Department of Transportation, and numerous firms have been invited to the chapter meetings. The SIUE Student Chapter has big plans for the coming year. SIUE's enthusiasm for participation will also follow them to the Midwestern ITE Challenge at the District Conference in the Iowa this summer.

In June 2010, four members from SIUE student chapter of ITE attended the Midwestern ITE traffic bowl held in Minneapolis. Members all got great experiences and made friends from other universities during this competition. Three ITE members competed in the Regional Competition On June 28, 2010. The SIUE Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) Chapter placed 4th out of 8 teams in the Midwestern Traffic Bowl sponsored by the Midwestern District. The team members were Michael Williamson, Jiguang Zhao and Mostafa Gahrooei. The Traffic Bowl is a Jeopardy-style competition where student teams of three answer questions related to transportation engineering, design, planning, and operations.

Jiguang Zhao and Jing Huang attended the ITE International Conference in Vancouver Canada. Jiguang gave two presentation: A Method to Evaluate Roadway Lighting Systems and the Safety Effects, and Examine the Factors that Affect the Number of Students Walking and Biking to School

ITE student chapter members volunteered in the Transportation Institute 2010 organized by Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), Southern Illinois University Carbondale and Edwardsville campus. Twenty two middle school students from East St Louis area received training on the career opportunities in transportation engineering. Including transportation by: rail, air, water, and highway.

### TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES

TEAM annually strives to offer multiple opportunities for training to our members. In 2010 TEAM offered two free webinar to its members:

- Overview of the 2009 MUTCD: Traffic Signals & Accessible Pedestrian Signals, held on Thursday, February 11, 2010—2:00pm-3:00pm, 1.0 PDHs provided.
- Sight Distance Webinar, November 12, 2010, 11:00 am -12:30 pm, 1.0 PDH's offered.

Our biggest event of the year is the annual TEAM Fair. This year's Fair was held Wednesday, September 29 (to coincide with the national "Put the Brakes on Fatalities Day"). It was held at the Maryland Heights Community Center, who graciously donates the facility to our group. Attendees have the opportunity to obtain 6.5 PDHs for the low registration fees of \$30 for members and \$40 for non-members. The extra cost for non-members is the membership fee so that all who attend the Fair become TEAM members. Together with TEAM, the 2010 Fair was hosted by: MOVITE, The City of Maryland Heights, MoDOT, and St. Louis County Highways & Traffic. Our excellent program of presentations included:

- Mississippi River Bridge
- Highway Safety manual
- Panel Discussion: Working Together to Improve Our Future
- Innovations out of the Indy Speedway
- Route 141 MoDOT and St. Louis County Coordination
- ARRA and LPA Federal Programs

This year's event drew 224 attendees, our biggest fair ever. We had 21 corporate sponsors. For a \$100 fee, the corporate sponsors were offered the booth space as well as recognition on various signs and the reverse side of the receipt/PDH form. This year we also collaborated with the US. Marine Corps to participate in their toys for tots program, we started accepting toys from the day of the fair and team members who brought toys with them were entered into a drawing to win transportation and TEAM related rewards. We continued to accept toys until the holidays. The program was a big success and we were able to collect quite a few toys.



## **AWARDS PROGRAM**

At a Board meeting in 2010 the group decided to lay the groundwork for annual awards. It was decided to initiate a “Transportation Professional of the Year” Award. Many qualified professionals were nominated by their peers and this year’s award went to Richard Beckman of St. Louis County Department of Highways and Traffic for his 35 years of service in the field of Transportation. Plans are to proceed in 2011 with a revision to the TEAM Bylaws. This revision will create an annual awards program for a Transportation Professional.
